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CAMPING IS LIMITED TO 160 UNITS

- Camping will be pre-allocated. Please clearly state on the entry form the name of the group/person you wish to camp with.
- Pitch fees are £25.00 for Friday and Saturday nights only
- Arrivals welcome from 3pm but no later than 9pm without prior agreement
- Pitches will be 8 x 6 metres and you must park within your pitch
- Please indicate on entry form if you would like your entry returned if camping is full
- Each unit/pitch must be equipped with its own fire extinguisher or bucket of water
- No barbeques or open fires are allowed at our venue
- Toilets and emptying points will be supplied, but there are no shower facilities
- The cricket pitch is out of bounds, anyone found on there will be asked to leave
- Generators to run only between 8am-10am and 6pm-8pm
- At the show the speed limit is 5mph

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WELFARE OF DOGS

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

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In case of cancellation of the show within seven days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant web sites and posted on applicable facebook groups where possible. It will be the competitor's responsibility to check with these services if continuation of the show is in doubt.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression. Agility classes to include contact obstacles and Jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

Class Structure. A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

Progression. Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins in standard classes at that grade, **at either Full height or the Lower Height Option**, except that progression from Grade 5 will require 3 wins at Grade 5, one of which must be an agility class. Progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

Lower Height Option. Societies may offer the Lower Height Option to all dogs in that height category and may be offered at all grades. It is to be run as part of any Standard class as defined in the regulations and must be clearly identified in the schedule. Each relevant class will have two heights with a change part way through to raise/lower the jump heights and competitors must run at their entered height. The order in which the heights will run must be detailed on the ring cards/ring plan. There will be only one course walking at the start of the class. In a class where the Lower Height Option is available show organisers may offer one set of awards by combining the results of each height or may offer separate awards for each height category. Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins. Hurdles may be raised/lowered during the course walking time if multiple heights are offered within the same class. When the Lower Height Option is scheduled a dog may only be entered at either the Full Height or the Lower Height and it cannot compete at a different height in any other class at that competition, including special classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule.

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers), except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of Agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade. Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

STANDARD CLASSES

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 (Elementary) - For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at a Kennel Club licensed Agility Show. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 (Starters) - Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at a Kennel Club licensed Agility Show or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 3 (Graduate) – Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows & dogs which are not eligible for Grades 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice) – Open to dogs which have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at a Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 3, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate) – Open to dogs which have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 4 at a Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior) – Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an Agility (not Jumping) Class, and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

STANDARD CLASSES

Grade 7 (Advanced) – Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 1st places at grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows, 2 first places must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes.

SPECIAL CLASSES

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as "Special classes". The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

Special Anysize Jumping

Open to dogs not entered in any other class on either day. This will be a simple flowing course particularly suitable for inexperienced dogs or handlers, and those dogs that are unable to compete at their full height. Jump heights will be: 45cm, 35cm and 23cm (micro). There will be no weaves, tyre or long jump. You may enter your dog at whichever jump height you wish regardless of your dog's size.

Special Helter Skelter

Open to Large, Medium and Small Dogs. Dogs will jump at their normal height. A class of only jumps and tunnels, no weaves or tyre.

SPECIAL CDAC'S CHAMPIONS CLASS - RULES

The CDAC's Champions Class will be a fun class by invite only on the day to every handler and dog that wins or comes runner up in a class on Saturday.

- 1) The class will be an Agility class.
- 2) Judged according to standard KC rules.
- 3) Handlers may enter more than one dog.
- 4) The course can only be walked before the start of the competition during which time all 3 heights will be set consecutively.
- 5) There will be 2 classes in total.
 - Combined Grades 1 to 3 at Small, Medium and Large
 - Combined Grades 4 to 7 at Small, Medium and Large
- 6) If you are placed, first or second in a class on the Saturday you are invited to enter the Champions Class at the end of the day. Please would you go to the secretaries tent to advise if you wish to enter the class.
- 7) Running orders will be given out on the day.
- 8) Trophies will be given to first and second place. Rosettes given to every place.
- 9) Only handlers and dogs that are invited to enter may run this class. No substitutes allowed.
- 10) All dogs to be ringside at the start of the class.
- 11) The class will start when all other rings have finished on Saturday.
- 12) Dogs will jump at:- Large = 65cms, LHO = 55cms, Medium = 45cms and Small = 35cms

DIRECTIONS

From M11: Leave the M11 at junction 8 and take the A120 signposted Braintree, stay on A120 passed Braintree for a further 5 miles. Then take B1024 (Left) signposted Earls Colne. Follow this road for approx 2.3 miles until you reach a pub called 'a bird in the hand'. Shortly after the pub there will be a turning on the left clearly marked 'Essex Golf and Country Club'. Once inside our stewards will be here to direct you to the designated area.

From M25: Leave the M25 at junction 28 and take the A12 Eastbound. Leave the A12 at junction 25 and take the A120. Follow this road for 4 miles, and then take the B1024 signposted Earls Colne. Follow this road for approx 2.3 miles until you reach a pub called 'a bird in the hand'. Shortly after the pub there will be a turning on the left clearly marked 'Essex Golf and Country Club'. Once inside our stewards will be here to direct you to the designated area.

From M25: Your sat nav's may direct you through Kelvedon or Coggeshall, please note these routes are not recommended with a caravan, both village High Streets are very narrow with lots of parked cars.

From A14: Leave the A14 at junction 55 and take the A12. Leave the A12 at junction 25 and take the A120. Follow this road for 4 miles, and then take the B1024 signposted Earls Colne. 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Show Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club regulations for classification & registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/authority to compete number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered & resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an ATC number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor
3. Entry fees: £3.20 per class or £2.50 per class for CDAC members. Camping fees: £25 per pitch or £15.00 per pitch for CDAC members.
4. There is no prize money offered at this show.
5. Internet entries will be accepted via www.agilityshows.online
6. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age & over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
9. Organisers of Open Agility shows may set a capping level on the entries to be accepted in any standard or special class, and may decline entries received after the capping level has been reached. State if specific classes are to be capped and the capping limit. The capping level must be set at a minimum of 250 entries received. There is no maximum level at which a cap may be set.
10. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months & over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
11. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
12. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competitions is forbidden.
13. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
14. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie not attached by a ring.
15. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
16. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
17. All offers of sponsorship as stated in the schedule.
18. Kennel Club Standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes.
19. The height of the hurdles will be:- Large dogs 65cms, Large LHO dogs 55cms, Medium dogs 45cms & Small dogs 35cms. For the Special Anysize classes Large dogs 35cms, Medium 25cms, & Small 23cms.
20. The height limit for dogs are:
 - a. Large Dogs Classes – For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers
 - b. Medium Dogs Classes – For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) & measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
 - c. Small Dogs classes – For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers

21. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the show at which they are judging. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.

22. Removal of dogs from Competition:

Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is:-

- a. A bitch which is in season
- b. Suffering from any infectious disease or contagious disease
- c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
- d. Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
- e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing

The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to the Kennel Club.

23. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.

24. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to & including 25 days before the start of the competition (19th June 2018) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry, for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show (31st July 2018). The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.

25. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultant with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes & the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.

26. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date. Entry fees up to the closing date will be refunded less reasonably incurred expenses. No refunds will be given after the closing date.

Should any cheque bounce we will contact you to advise of this & you will be required to collect your running orders from the Secretary tent at the show in return for full payment in cash plus £10 towards the bank charges the show would have incurred.

27. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.

28. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result &/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.

29. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner & must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

30. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete.

Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined &/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.

31. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class & running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.

32. Animals in Event

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dog registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Board. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease & that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

33. Pay on the day classes will be held if time permits.

34. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring will be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.

35. Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, & should not knowingly put their dogs' health & welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules & Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

36. All dogs are entered at this Show at the owners risk & whilst the committee will take every reasonable care, it shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury, howsoever caused to dogs, people or property at the Show.

37. Respect the venue & pick up after your dog(s) & dispose of all rubbish in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the venue & will forfeit any remaining class entries.

38. Any person under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

39. Children under the age of 11 are the responsibility of and must be accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian including when competing

40. The cricket pitch is out of bounds, anyone found on there will be asked to leave.

41. Organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the show/showground for actions deemed detrimental to the show.

42. If you enter the show by paper entry form and choose to download your ring cards you are agreeing for the information on them to be publically viewable online.

43. The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publically available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
